The successful candidate for this role will be a strong negotiator, and have exceptional interpersonal and relationship-building skills.

The other Principal, Private Investments will be focused primarily on evaluating and structuring principal investment transactions alongside our fund managers and other institutional investors. The successful candidate will play a lead role in sourcing, researching and evaluating investment opportunities in private equity and infrastructure, negotiating investment terms and coordinating management of the investments with our partners. The successful candidate for this role will demonstrate outstanding financial analysis, research and negotiation abilities, and have a strong understanding of valuation methodologies.

A university degree in business, finance or economics is required, supplemented by a professional designation, such as CFA, CBV or an accounting designation. A minimum of seven years relevant experience in the investment management profession is required, including specific experience in infrastructure, private equity, corporate development or investment banking.
