

CFASP Mock Exam, May 17, 2008

What:

The mock CFA exam will be available for each of the three levels. These exams are provided by the Boston Security Analysts Society. They are constructed based on the most recent Candidate Body of Knowledge Learning Outcome Statements and the most recently used test formats.

Your exam will include both morning and afternoon sections, each three hours long and formatted like the actual exam. You will also receive an answer key containing not only the correct answers, but explanations, relevant calculations, and references to applicable portions of the curriculum. The exam will be held under conditions that simulate the actual test environment.

Where:

Portland State University School of Business Administration, Room 160.

The School of Business is located on the block between 6th and Broadway, and between Harrison on the South and Montgomery on the north. Immediately across the street to the south is a parking structure, where you can park all day Saturday for \$4.

When:

Saturday, May 17. The morning session will be from 9:00 to 12:00; the afternoon session from 1:00 to 4:00. Please arrive no later than 8:40 to assure that you can be checked in before the exam begins. (You are not required to stay for the exam; however, you must come in person to purchase the exam.)

Cost:

\$75, payable by check (payable to CFA Society of Portland) or cash. Please bring your payment to the exam.
