

## **Ethics in Finance (EiF) is Seeking Volunteers**

The Ethics in Finance (EiF) project is a collaboration of CFA Society Seattle, CFA Institute and several Pacific Northwest universities. Our goal is to encourage and support ethics education for business and finance students and foster ethical decision making in future business leaders.

We have created an easily accessible ethics in finance curriculum, from which university professors can draw upon materials and incorporate in their own courses. This curriculum is currently being reviewed by a small group of university professors (peer reviewers) to gain their insights before it is shared more widely.

### **We have prioritized two areas for which we need volunteers:**

- First, we need help in incorporating the thoughts and ideas of the peer review instructors and in editing the final curriculum offering to include any needed changes or additions. This role will involve communicating with peer reviewers and authors, collecting feedback, and working with other EiF Working Group members in making any recommended revisions. The position will begin as soon as possible.
- Second, we plan to expand our scope to more universities. This role will involve conducting outreach and enlisting additional university instructors as peer reviewers, including using the curriculum materials in their classes in the Fall of 2018.
